

Dear Applicant,

With reference to your application for admission into the M.Ed Programme being offered by this University, it is to inform you that you are provisionally selected for the Counselling for admission into the above Programme. You are required to attend the interview at your own expenses on 25-02-2010 at 10.00 AM in the Conference Hall, Academic Building of the University.

It may be noted that mere calling for interview will not automatically entitle you for a seat in the Programme. More number of eligible candidates than the seats available has been called for interview. The admission is subject to availability of the seat as per rules. The candidate should satisfy the eligibility criteria laid down in the notification and prospectus. The admissions are subject to the rules of the Government, NCTE and the University.

Documents Required:

You should submit the following documents in ORIGINAL at the time of interview.

1. Hall Ticket
2. Rank Card
3. Transfer Certificate
4. Migration Certificate
5. i) 'Service Certificate' and 'No Objection Certificate' signed by the Head Master/Principal and countersigned by the MEO in the case of regular teachers working in Government Schools/Local Bodies/Aided Schools and in all other cases the certificate shall be countersigned by the MEO and DEO.  
ii) Teachers / HMs / Principals / Lecturers working in private institutions (Colleges) are to obtain 'Service Certificate' and 'No Objection Certificate' counter signed by DEO / RJD.  
iii) Persons working in the Administration of Education Department are to produce 'Service Certificate' and 'No Objection Certificate' from the respective Head of the Institution / Department.
6. Study Certificate from IX to Degree, B.Ed and Residence Certificate issued by an appropriate authority as per rules.
7. Duly issued Integrated Community Certificate in case of SC/ST/BC candidates.
8. Certificate issued by Competent Authority in case of PH candidates.
9. Degree Certificate.
10. B.Ed Certificate.
11. B.Ed Marks statements.
12. Conduct certificate.
13. SSC / Proof of Date of Birth.
14. Two Recent Passport size Photographs
15. A set of Xerox copies of all the above certificates (i.e Sl. No. 1 to 13 are to be submitted).
16. A Demand Draft issued by any Nationalized Bank. Preferably SBI or SBH or Andhra Bank for Rs.35, 000/- (Rupees Thirty five thousand only) drawn in favour of The Registrar, Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Open University, Hyderabad (only candidates offered provisional admission will be required to submit the Demand Draft)

If, it is found that the admission is on false grounds or suppression of facts, the admission will be cancelled at any time during the course and the candidate is liable for criminal prosecution.

If selected, the study centre will be allotted at the discretion of the Director (SS), giving due consideration to the choice of the candidate as far as possible.
